

Good afternoon to our Chamlian Family,

Our entire Chamlian Family is in our hearts as we navigate through the next few weeks. Keeping you informed and providing you certainty about the continuity of your child's education is our primary goal during the time when the school is operating online. Our office is now fully operating remotely and the Administration Staff had a productive first remote meeting via our virtual office.

We will take advantage of the campus being vacant during the next two weeks to sanitize all facilities. Since Friday, we have thoroughly cleaned and sanitized all surfaces, chairs, desks, bleachers, doors and bathrooms in the gym, auditorium and the junior high building. We will continue this process to incrementally clean all remaining facilities. Per recent studies, the COVID-19 virus survives on hard surfaces between 24 to 48 hours. We have no confirmed cases of the virus on our campus. Sanitizing removes 99.99% of bacteria, viruses and microbes. Sterilizing is a more complex process of destroying microorganisms; this is not a practical approach to cleaning a school campus.

You have by now received an email from your student's core teacher(s) regarding our Distance Learning Program (DLP). Parents and students should check their emails by 4:00 PM everyday for details about assignments due the following day. The first email about instructions and assignments will be sent tomorrow, Tuesday, March 17, 2020, from the core teachers. In the meantime, please help your child with setting up the necessary platforms by Tuesday afternoon. Also, you can help find the best place in your home to do homework and create a daily schedule for them for a new routine at home.
