## Clinical Approach to Guide Evaluation of ED Patients with Symptoms of COVID-19 For ED/Hospital Provider (3/13/20)

Patient presents with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 infection (fever and cough)

Mask patient immediately and put in separate room



Perform diagnostic tests as indicated (blood work, CXR, rapid flu test, etc.)



Patient requires hospitalization?





YES

- Collect NP swab for COVID-19; see box below.
- Instruct patient to isolate at home until test results return
- Collect NP swab for COVID-19; see box below





Notify OCHCA about suspect case pending results only if patient is a resident or employee of a senior living facility (SNF/LTCF or assisted living)

Able to send specimens to LabCorp or Quest?

NO



Call OCHCA to discuss case; OCHCA will test if:

- 1. Patient is hospitalized with respiratory illness
- Patient has cough OR fever and close contact<sup>2</sup> with a confirmed case, OR
- 3. Patient has cough and fever and
  - Is a healthcare worker, OR
  - Is a resident of a skilled nursing facility, OR
  - Has returned from a country at risk in last 14 days<sup>3</sup>

If approved for testing at OCHCA, collect NP swab and refrigerate specimen and PHL courier will pick up next business day (freeze specimen if collected Friday or Saturday)



YES

- Collect NP swab and send to commercial lab
- For other specimen types, check with commercial lab to assure correct specimens are submitted



- 1. Close contact is defined as being within approximately 6 feet (2 meters) of a COVID-19 case for over 2 minutes
