6. How is this charge (v. 64) both justifiable and unjustifiable?
7. What is the kind of discipleship that Jesus desires? (v. 55-65)
8. What mix of motives brings Peter into the high priest's courtyard yet keeps him from acknowledging his relationship to Jesus? (v. 66-72)
9. How is Judas's betrayal of Jesus different from Peter's?
10. What warnings and encouragement can you draw from Peter's experience?
