Overview of the ACC 3.0 Chronic Conditions Shared Savings Program:

- Upside-only program for adult members with chronic conditions.
- Practices must meet cost thresholds and at least two ACC 3.0 quality measures.
- RAE 1 priority conditions: Diabetes, Hypertension, Asthma.
- Reviewed participation requirements, risk stratification approaches, and RAE support.

- Importance of well-care visits for ages 3–21.
- Documentation requirements and exclusion criteria.
- Best practices for closing care gaps, outreach, and capturing opportunities during sick visits.
