☐ **ACC 3.0 Implementation Timeline**

- **Planning Phase (Aug–Dec 2025):** Practices should meet with their CPMs, select QI activities, identify champions and teams, and prepare for CY 2026.
- **Implementation Phase (Jan–Dec 2026):** Practices will execute QI activities, report eCQM data quarterly, and meet regularly with CPMs.

☐ **PRIME Reinvestment Criteria**

- Applies to practices in **PRIME counties** (e.g., Mesa, Montrose, Garfield).
- Must report quarterly on:
 - **CMS 2: Depression Screening (Target: 66.33%)**
 - **CMS 122: Diabetes A1c Poor Control (>9%) – Pay for reporting**
 - **CMS 137: SUD Treatment Initiation & Engagement (Targets: Part A – 59.60%, Part B – 16.80%)**
- Q4 workflow submissions due **Jan 31, 2026**
