

Dear Valued Provider,

As a contracted provider in Rocky Mountain Health Plans (RMHP) and NHP's [Behavioral Health Value-Based Payment \(VBP\) Program](#), we want to alert you to an important update regarding your reimbursement rates.

The 2025 lookback period for our [VBP](#) program is coming to a close on **December 31, 2025**. Criteria for the CY2025 lookback (used to determine rates effective in SFY2027) were distributed in October 2024 and remain available for reference here: [Enhanced reimbursement criteria for July 1, 2026–June 30, 2027](#).

You are receiving this email because **your rates are anticipated to decrease** based on your current performance in the CY2025 lookback period.

If you want to maintain or improve your Star rating, there is still time to act. Here are **two options that can help you earn additional points before the lookback closes**:

Option 1: Participate in [Violet and Achieve Benchmarks](#)

- Engage with Violet and meet the required benchmarks before December 31, 2025. This is a key opportunity to boost your score and protect your rates.

Option 2: [Register for and Complete the “Unlocking Dual Diagnoses” Training](#)

- **Registration opens January 12, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. MT.**
- **Live Zoom sessions will be held on:**
 - Jan 14, Jan 28, Feb 11, Feb 25, Mar 11, and Mar 25
- Completing this training will count toward your points for the CY2025 lookback period.

Please also ensure your contact information is up to date in the [provider express portal](#) so you don't miss critical updates.

In April 2026, RMHP will send via email, a summary of the points your practice achieved during the 2025 calendar year lookback period, and the resulting rate enhancement percentage. Please note that your reimbursement rates may go up or down compared to your current rate, based on performance. Any rate changes will take effect on July 1, 2026.
