INDIANAPOLIS, IND., April 19, 2022 -- Deeply Ingrained, Inc. (DBA Socially Distant Woodworking) began its work during the stay-at-home orders in April 2020.

Each month Deeply Ingrained designs, manufactures, and distributes a unique woodworking project to the community at no cost. Projects have included lanterns, picture frames, holiday centerpieces, and games, among much more. Deeply Ingrained has produced and distributed over 16,000 projects since the first distribution.

Deeply Ingrained growth initiatives focus on at-risk and mentally/physically challenged youth and young adults in the Indianapolis community. The organization strives to offer underserved youth unique hands-on opportunities. Deeply Ingrained is actively working with existing K-12 afterschool and summer program organizations to introduce our new Woodshop on Wheels (WOW) enrichment program.

This weekend, WOW is making its debut at the [Republic Airways Plane Pull](#) event. The centerpiece of this program is a fully equipped woodshop built inside a twenty-four-foot enclosed trailer offering participants the ability to visit and work in a well-equipped workshop without leaving their neighborhood. Through Deeply Ingrained partnerships, the organization can reach those most challenged and create positive change in lives, families, neighborhoods, communities, and Indianapolis.
