BYLAWS & CONSTITUTION CHANGES

In accordance with the Phi Sigma Sigma Constitution, the bylaws committee shall solicit, review and submit constitutional and bylaws changes to the electorate every biennium. The bylaws committee will consider submissions, and those submissions receiving a majority vote by the bylaws committee will be presented to Supreme Council for approval. Those submissions receiving a majority vote of Supreme Council will be presented to the electorate for approval at the 2022 Phi Sigma Sigma Convention.

All submissions for changes are due by **Monday, January 24, 2022 at 11:59 P.M. PT**. No late submissions will be accepted.

Pursuant to Article XIII, Section 2 of the Constitution, proposed changes will be shared with the electorate no later than April 15, 2022.

VOTING DELEGATES

Per the Constitution, only designated Convention delegates including collegiate and alumnae chapter archons, chapter key advisors, standing committee chairmen and Supreme Council will be eligible to vote on Fraternity business including bylaws and constitution revision. In order to be eligible to vote, chapters must be in good standing with the Fraternity.

As outlined in Section IV, Section 2 of the Constitution, voting on resolutions and amendments to the Fraternity's constitution and bylaws shall be weighted based on the number of voting members at a particular Convention. Collegiate votes will be weighted in such a manner to account for 51% of the total vote, while alumnae delegate votes will account for 49% of the total vote.



SUBMITTING A PROPOSED CHANGE

If you have a constitution or bylaws amendment for consideration, please initiate the process by signing up here for a consultation call with representatives of the bylaws committee.

Please note that a rationale for each submission is also required. The rationale may be used by the bylaws committee for educational/promotional purposes.

PROCESS & TIMELINE

The following outlines a timeline of the process:

DECEMBER

- Call for bylaws and constitution changes on December 15

JANUARY

- Proposed bylaws and constitution changes due January 24

MARCH

- Present proposed bylaws changes to Supreme Council for approval

APRIL-JUNE

- Announce approved proposed bylaws and constitution changes to electorate
Information and education on plenary & proposed bylaws and constitution changes
