



Brush Up Bartlesville is a City/community initiative which began last year as a collaboration between local citizens, non profits, local sponsors and supported in part by the City of Bartlesville. This year's event is being coordinated by the Young Professionals of Bartlesville with Bartlesville City Council and YP associate member Billie Roane and City of Bartlesville Neighborhood Services.

The second annual Brush Up event will be held this year between June and October, beginning with applications submitted for review beginning June 5-June 9. This program is designed to assist Bartlesville low-income homeowners by offering exterior trim painting services to those in greatest need. There is no financial obligation by the homeowner, but in-kind participation is requested.

Homeowners must meet the following criteria:

- Own & live in the home requested for trim paint
- Title to the property must be in applicant's name
- Meet Combined Annual Gross Income Maximum Limits
- Home must be determined to be in need of trim paint
- Home must be located in the City of Bartlesville
- Home must carry active insurance policy
- All taxes and liens on property must be paid in full
- Home and surfaces to be painted must be structually sound
