Directed by Sidney Lumet, this black-and-white film is often
called an action film, even though all its action is verbal
and the only setting is an unadorned room in need of air-
conditioning. In terms of created tension and camera
movement, *12 Angry Men* is as close to perfect as a film
can be. The great Henry Fonda
plays the only holdout in the jury
deliberations of a murder trial.
The story tracks Fonda's
persuasive arguments to the
eleven other jury members. Paul
Marino leads the discussion.
