into the lives and realities of Los Angelinos in a
post-9/11 world. The many characters of various
race and ethnic identities intersect on and off
throughout the story line, not unlike the many
access and exit ramps of the busy, I-405 corridor around L.A. It's a fitting
metaphor, as most of the movie's action takes place on city streets. *Crash*
exposes the everyday prejudices that exist among citizens of this diverse city

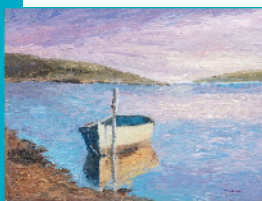

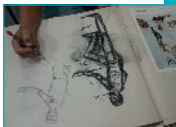

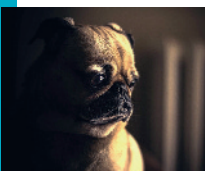
