Director Barry Jenkins 2018 film adaptation of James Baldwin's 1974 novel, the story centers around Tish and Fonny, a couple living in Harlem during the 1970s who are deeply in love and excited about the future. Then Fonny is falsely accused of a crime and sent to prison. Tish, who learns she is pregnant, must fight to get Fonny exonerated. The story's larger theme of racial injustice makes this beautiful film disturbingly relevant and poignant today. Nominated for several Academy Awards, the film received a 95% approval rating from critics. Paul Marino leads the discussion.
