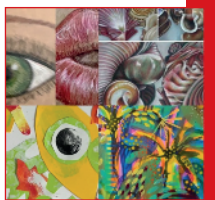

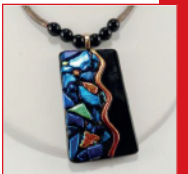

ART IN THE FORM OF FILM INVASION OF THE BODY SNATCHERS / DEC 16

FRIDAY 5:45-9pm

This 1956 film, adapted from a novel by Jack Finney, was named by critics as one of the best horror/sci-fi movies ever made. It hit the silver screen in the mid-Fifties amid rising fears of communism and blacklisting. Many people saw a foreboding political allegory, although Finney defended his work as nothing more than entertainment. Allegory or not, the film similarly seems to speak to a growing tide of anxiety in today's America. There have been three remakes, but none compares to the original zombie-like pod people in this black and white classic. Instructor Paul Marino hosts the discussion. 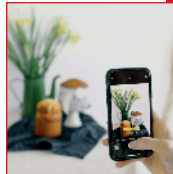
