### GUIDELINES

#### Humanitarian of the Year Award

##### QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have accomplished an outstanding humanitarian and/or civic deed or deeds for the benefit of Acadia Parish and the community.
- Must not have received remuneration for said work, nor done it in the regular line of duty.
- No person presently holding an elected office of political nature will be eligible to receive the award.

Candidates should be selected based on their contribution in one or more of the following areas:

##### COMMUNITY SERVICES:

1. Civic improvement
2. Mental health activities
3. Aid to and promotion of employment of the handicapped
4. Aid or assistance to the elderly
5. Physical health and recreational activities

##### RELIGIOUS:

1. Dedication to individual activities of the honoree's own faith
2. Outstanding efforts to promote high standards of moral and ethical conduct both publicly and privately

##### EDUCATIONAL:

1. Outstanding activity toward the improvement of quality of education both public and private
2. Interest in and promotion of adult education
3. Trade and industrial school activities
4. Promotion of community awareness of the need for continuing education
