Invoicing Process:

60 – 90 days prior to due date - invoices get mailed

60 days prior to due date - Membership Committee Members will call/email those members that are coming due to thank them for their membership. (sample attached in email)

30 days prior to due date – For those that have not yet paid, they will receive their invoice stamped with reminder and The 10 Reasons to Belong flyer mailed to them.

15 days past due – Past Due Invoice mailed to them

30 days past due – A Board Member will call them

45 – 60 days past due – I will call and/or send a cancellation notice

When a member pays their membership dues – within a week they will receive a thank you email (sample attached in email)

New Member Process:

1 – 2 days of joining – New members will receive a welcome email (inserted in email)

1 – 2 weeks from joining – They will receive a new member packet

Within 2 weeks of upcoming BIA – The Whole Picture, they will receive an invite from me to attend the event.

6 months from join date – They will receive a phone call from a membership committee member or their sponsor/spike checking in on their membership so far. (sample attached in email)

On going –

- They will receive our bi-weekly e-news letter which includes upcoming events, education classes, Association News and Government Affairs
- They will receive printed newsletter each quarter
- They will receive a new member ribbon at events that they attend so membership committee members and Board members can easily recognize them and introduce themselves.
