Re: PBA Dues Increase Effective January 1, 2020

I want to thank each of the local association presidents and executive officers who attended this weekend's board meeting. Your engagement and support strengthen our federation and enable us to carry out our mission at the state level. For those of you who may have missed Saturday's board meeting, I wanted to ensure that you received and understood the following news.

2020 PBA Budget

At their meeting on Saturday, the PBA board overwhelmingly approved the 2020 budget proposal. That budget includes two particularly important aspects affecting local associations.

- 1) The board increased annual builder and associate dues from \$155 annually to \$160 (not including the \$20 IAF assessment.)
- 2) The board instituted a brand-new dues amount for affiliate members. Previously, PBA charged zero dues for affiliates. In the new year, PBA affiliates dues will be \$5 per affiliate.

The dues changes are intended to help PBA address annual inflationary and other cost increases. ***Please note that both the builder and association dues increase, and the new affiliate dues are effective as of January 1st, 2020.*** We recognize that some locals bill their members well in advance, so we are giving you as much notice as we are able.
