PROCLAMATION FOR VOLUNTARY EVACUATION
STATE OF EMERGENCY AMENDMENT NO. 4**

WHEREAS, On July 31, 2020, under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 33 of the Town of Holden Beach Code of Ordinances, the Town of Holden Beach declared a State of Emergency based on the storm track of Hurricane Isaias; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to the State of Emergency was issued on August 3, 2020, Amendment No. 2 was issued on August 4, 2020 and Amendment No. 3 was issued on August 4, 2020.


NOW THEREFORE, I, J. Alan Holden, Mayor of the Town of Holden Beach, do amend the State of Emergency issued on July 31, 2020, as amended on August 3, 2020 (Amendment No. 1) and August 4, 2020 (Amendments No. 2 & 3) as follows:

1. Rental occupancy is still prohibited until further notice.
2. Holden Beach 2020 Decal access is no longer required.

All other restrictions currently in place shall remain in force until rescinded or amended.
