CODE OF ETHICS FOR RENEWING MEMBERS

NAR's Board of Directors [approved a change to the Code of Ethics training requirement](#), extending it from every two years to **every three years**. This extends the current cycle deadline from Dec. 31, 2020, to **Dec. 31, 2021**.

REALTORS® are required to complete ethics training of not less than 2 hours, 30 minutes of instructional time. The training must meet specific learning objectives and criteria established by the National Association of REALTORS®. The TREC Legal Update 2 will no longer satisfy the NAR Code of Ethics training requirement effective January 1, 2020. Code of Ethics training may be completed online for FREE. Meet this requirement through NAR, CCAR, or by completing the C2EX Endorsement. **Please note that if you have taken TREC Legal Update 2 in 2019 your requirement has been met.**

CODE OF ETHICS FOR NEW MEMBERS

All new REALTOR® members must complete NAR Code of Ethics within 45 days of joining CCAR. This course may be completed online for free by visiting [NAR Code of Ethics](#). If this requirement is not met within the first 45 days of joining, membership may be subject to suspension.

FIRST TIME RENEWALS

If you are in your first two years of having your license, you will need to take 90hrs of SAE (Sales Apprentice Education) credit and the Mandatory TREC Legal 1 (4hrs CE) and TREC Legal 2 (4hrs CE). In total, you need to complete 98 hours of education before your first renewal.
