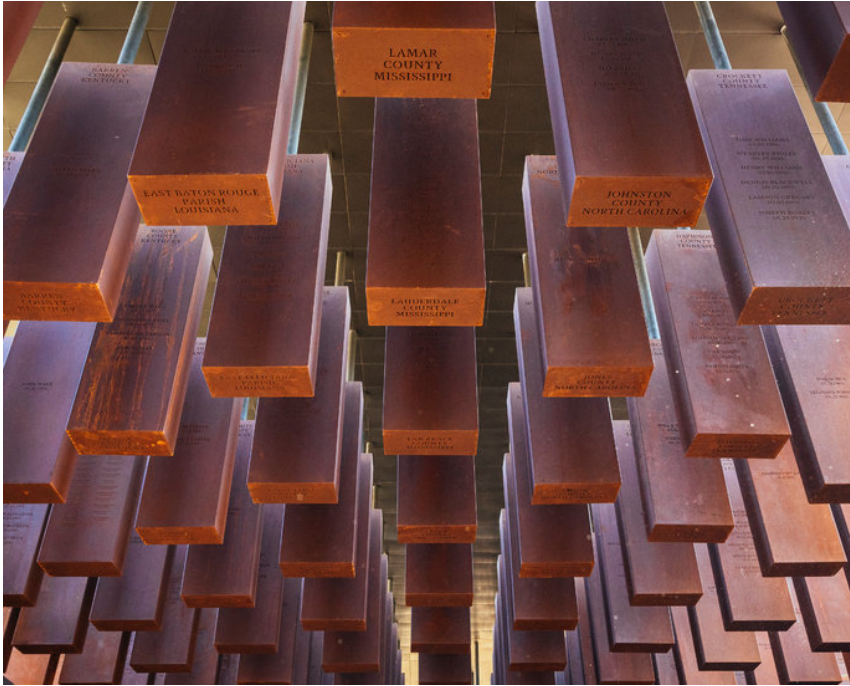


Pilgrimage to Montgomery
