We are pleased to welcome back Dr. Ian Markham, Dean and President of Virginia Theological Seminary, who was our 2014 speaker. Before his appointment as Dean of THE SEMINARY in August 2007, he was Dean and Professor of Theology and Ethics at Hartford Seminary in Connecticut. Previously he served as Visiting Professor of Globalization Ethics, and Islam at Leeds Metropolitan University in the United Kingdom. He has also held faculty positions at Liverpool Hope University and the University of Exeter.

He completed his PhD at the University of Exeter in the United Kingdom where he focused on Christian Ethics. He previously earned an M.Litt. in Philosophy and Ethics from the University of Cambridge and a B.D. in Theology from the University of London.

Dean Markham is the author and editor of numerous books, including *Liturgical Life Principles: How Episcopal Worship Can Lead to Healthy and Authentic Living*; *Christ and Culture: Communion After Lambeth*; and *Do Morals Matter*. Dr. Markham spoke on *Liturgical Life Principles* at our 2014 conference.

This year he challenges us to examine our faith to discover if it matters in politics. Come and be a part of "the best little men's conference" in the Episcopal Church and welcome back our distinguished speaker.

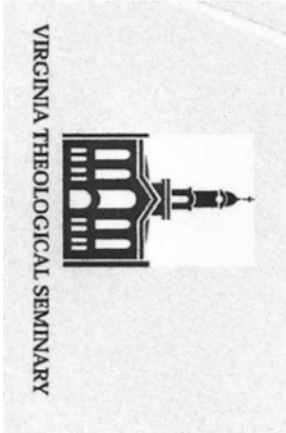
