CLERGY RESOURCE REMINDERS

- MyCPG Accounts Enhancements: In addition to viewing benefits, employees can now update their addresses, emails, phone numbers, and other personal information, quickly, conveniently, and safely at MyCPG Accounts on www.cpg.org. Remember employees sign in using their email address, username, or client number and password.
- Colleague Group Benefit The colleague group benefit is available to employees and spouses on Episcopal Church Medical Trust insurance plans for a total of 24, 90-minute sessions per year per person or family. The plan will cover 70% to the maximum reimbursable fee (MRF) of \$40.00. For example, if you participate in a colleague group and your facilitator charges \$75.00 a session, the plan will reimburse \$40.00 (70% of \$75.00 is \$52.50, but the MRF is \$40.00). SAFEGUARDING TRAINING (ONLINE)

Our ministries to children and youth are a vital part of the mission of our church; training in the prevention, detection, and reporting of sexual abuse helps us to provide a safe environment. Safeguarding is primarily about *abuse prevention training* and is **mandatory** for those working with and around children and youth. Anyone can take these online modules at any time and at your own pace. INSURANCE UPDATES / INFORMATION

- Zurich American Life Insurance Company (Zurich) has been selected as the new administrator for CPG's group short-term and long-term disability benefits programs, effective January 1, 2020. A one-time enrollment is currently underway for 7 churches; all have been notified by CPG and will work directly with them. There will later be a one-time "Open Enrollment" period early next year for all other eligible employees that wish to add STD/LTD benefits (without medical underwriting). We will share this information when CPG makes it available.
- Effective June 1, 2019, all hurricane and flood deductibles were reduced to 2% with no additional premiums due in 2019. Church Insurance will incorporate this change into our base rates when our policies are next renewal.
