Wyckoff Recreation Registration Policies apply as follow:

All new registrations or additions of weeks, if available, will be subject to a \$25 late fee after May 17, 2020. These changes will be accepted only if space allows. Refunds or credits to the registration system are only available through 6/8/20 and includes a \$25.00 cancellation processing fee. There are no refunds or credits to the registration system as of 6/9/20.

All Wyckoff Residents need to complete an Online Registration between the above dates along with submitting a copy of current immunization records which has been signed or stamped by a physician and dated within one year of 6/29/20 via fax (201-891-0672) or emailed to wyckoffrec@wyckoff-nj.com. No camper can attend camp until the Recreation Department receives the immunization record and any medications, if applicable. All medicines must be submitted in the original container along with a physician's allergy plan or other administration of medication instructions. It should have your child's name and incoming grade on the outside of a clear plastic bag. Please be sure to submit these required documents ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE START OF CAMP.

A "Parent Pack" of Information will be emailed to you one week prior to the start of camp. This pack will include additional information including all permission slips, emergency medical authorization, etc. Please be sure to read this information carefully. There will be no additional charges for trips, art supplies, entertainment, or transportation. Camp will not remain open for campers who choose not to go on a particular trip, however, all camp trips are optional.
