

VEGETATIVE WASTE DEFINED AND THE TYPES OF RECEPTACLES TO PLACE AT THE CURB FOR COLLECTION

- **VEGETATIVE WASTE** (garden debris, tree branches less than 3 inches in diameter and 3 feet in length, shrubbery trimmings – NO root balls) must be placed in an open container or the biodegradable brown paper bags that can be found at local hardware and home improvement stores. (Landscaping barrels may NOT be used because their large size makes them difficult to handle). Containers and/or bags must be placed at the curb before 6 am.
- **NO GRASS OR LEAVES WILL BE COLLECTED.**
- **VEGETATIVE WASTE DOES NOT** include: firewood, logs, stumps, grass, rocks or building materials.
- **Vegetative Waste must be placed in open containers.** Vegetative Waste placed in plastic bags **WILL NOT** be collected. Landscaping barrels may not be used because their large size makes them difficult to handle.
- **Vegetative Waste** may also be brought to the Township Recycling Center at 476 W. Main Street for recycling once it reopens.
