- Never use relationships with students for personal gain. Do not contact students for job opportunities at your company. We want to ensure our management companies that their team members will not be recruited by one of the instructors.
- Teachers will not discriminate against students for any reason. Treat every student with kindness and respect without showing any favoritism, prejudice, or partiality.
- Do not share any information about the students to anyone other than the AAKC Education Director.
- Teachers must model strong character traits, including honesty, respect, fairness, and patience.
