Only a 10-mile drive from The Thayer Hotel, **Garrison**, **NY** is Cold Spring's pastoral neighbor to the south and there are several locations of note to visit there as well.

Boscobel House and Gardens

A must-visit is **Boscobel House and Gardens**, a Neoclassical mansion restored back to its original grandeur. Boscobel features lush gardens and a woodland trail. Boscobel directly overlooks Constitution Marsh toward the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, showcasing dramatic views of the Hudson River. Boscobel is also the site of the **Cold Spring Farmer's Market**.

Manitoga / Russel Wright Center

A National Historic Landmark, Manitoga is a tranquil modernist home and Japanese-inspired woodland garden curated over many years by the industrial designer Russel Wright. Mid-century modern enthusiasts will enjoy visiting Dragon Rock, the House, Studio, and Design Gallery designed by architect David Leavitt in 1958.
