Only a 10-mile drive from The Thayer Hotel, Garrison, NY is Cold Spring's pastoral neighbor to the south and there are several locations of note to visit there as well.

Boscobel House and Gardens

*A must-visit is **Boscobel House and Gardens**, a Neoclassical mansion restored back to its original grandeur. Boscobel features lush gardens and a woodland trail. Boscobel directly overlooks Constitution Marsh toward the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, showcasing dramatic views of the Hudson River. Boscobel is also the site of the **Cold Spring Farmer's Market**.*

Manitoga / Russel Wright Center

A National Historic Landmark, Manitoga is a tranquil modernist home and Japanese-inspired woodland garden curated over many years by the industrial designer Russel Wright. Mid-century modern enthusiasts will enjoy visiting Dragon Rock, the House, Studio, and Design Gallery designed by architect David Leavitt in 1958.
