

COLD SPRING

Looking for a quaint Hudson River village? Only a 14-mile-drive from The Thayer Hotel, Cold Spring, NY is close to hiking trails and features an eclectic mix of historical sites, galleries, shops, bars & restaurants, and much more.

Tip from a Local..., Cold Spring gets crowded on weekends. Visit during the week for easier access to parking, fewer lines at restaurants, and less-crowded trails.

West Point Foundry Reserve

Love local history? Visit the West Point Foundry Preserve. The National Historic Landmark is the site of the 19th century ironworks that manufactured some of America's first steam engines, locomotives, and cannons that helped win the Civil War.

<u>Putnam History Museum</u>

Follow that up with a visit to the Putnam History Museum where a West Point Foundry exhibition includes photographs, artifacts, paintings, maps, and videos highlighting the Foundry related objects within the collection, including a fully restored Parrott Rifle.

<u>Magazzino Italian Art</u>

A short drive from the village is Magazzino Italian Art — a museum dedicated to postwar and contemporary Italian art. Arte Povera (impoverished art) is on permanent exhibition, while a selection of exquisite Murano glassworks be on display through March 2025.
