Dining Safety Protocols

We will be following NY State, Department of Public Health, CDC and FDA guidelines. Some highlights of differences to times you have dined in the past include:

- Reservations are required.
- Seatings may be limited to 90 minutes.
- Individuals seated at the same table must be members of the same party (but may be from different households), with a maximum of 10 people per table.
- Guests must wear masks when in the hotel, and until they are seated at their tables. If you don't have one, we can provide one to you upon entry of the hotel.
- Guest parties should remain 6' apart while waiting to be seated.
- Guests entering West Point will be asked three health screening questions:
 - Do you have any of the following symptoms: fever of greater than 100 degrees, cough or shortness of breath?
 - Have you traveled to or through anywhere outside of the United States in the last 14 days?
 - Have you or someone you have been in close contact with been confirmed to have COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
- We ask that guests wait to join us until you are feeling healthy: please do not come to the hotel when you are sick.
- Guests should wash and sanitize hands prior to dining: hand sanitizer stations are available, as well as public restrooms for hand washing.
- Our staff will undergo a health screening before the start of their shift, and will be wearing masks, serving, and preparing your delicious food and drinks in accordance with New York State, Department of Public Health, CDC and FDA guidelines.
