INTEGRATED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH FOR PRIMARY CARE PROVIDERS ECHO



This ECHO aims to improve behavioral health care for patients by providing health care providers, administrators and executives practical insights on patient care. Topics include harm reduction techniques, recognizing signs and symptoms of behavioral health conditions, understanding differences in diagnoses and using screening tools.

BUILDING COMMUNITY: BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PRACTITIONER COLLABORATIVE ECHO



This ECHO aims to bring behavioral health practitioners from across Illinois together to build community in order to reduce the silo effect among providers. Through collaboration, participants will share lived experiences, exchange best practices and support one another in navigating challenging cases.

TELEHEALTH FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROVIDERS ECHO



This ECHO is for health care providers, administrators and executives to provide insights on using telehealth practices in delivering client care. Topics covered will enhance their ability to identify behavioral health needs, establish effective care plans and build stronger professional teams.

CLINICAL SUPERVISION ECHO



This ECHO is designed to strengthen clinical supervision by providing health care supervisors with practical strategies for use in clinical settings. Participants will learn how to identify ethical and legal issues, apply culturally responsive supervision techniques and use tools that help reduce burnout.
