



## 2021 MBA Safety Champion Award Application

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. The Safety Champion Award (SCA) is open to any front-line supervisor/field personnel, from MBA member companies, that supervises work and is responsible for implementing established safety policies among their direct reports as well as skilled-trade partners, e.g., foreman, superintendent, project manager.

Front-line supervisors/field personnel can nominate themselves or they can be nominated by someone in their organization. The SCA is also open to corporate, regional, and/or project safety professionals from MBA member companies. Safety professionals can nominate themselves or they can be nominated by someone in their organization.

2. Front-line supervisors/field personnel from a company with a fatality on any of its projects or within its entire corporate structure which includes, if applicable, a parent company **within the application year (2021)** may not compete. This includes all full, part-time, contract or company employees, temporary labor agency hires or subcontractor employees. If a nominee's company experiences a fatality following the submission of the award, but prior to the presentation of the award, the nominee will be disqualified from the competition. This rule is in place to protect the integrity of the awards process.
3. The SCA recognizes a front-line supervisor/field personnel who has led his or her company to achieving an exceptionally high degree of safety excellence. As such, please do not treat the application process as a marketing exercise. The use of photos, logos and/or other marketing tools/materials, unless otherwise specified, will result in a point deduction at the time of preliminary judging. Do not submit any materials to which you do not have the copyright and other proprietary rights.
4. Your application will be judged by experienced safety and health professionals.
5. Awards Ceremony - The award will be presented on February 24, 2022, during the MBA Building Excellence Awards Program at Heinz Field.

- Award presentation: February 24, 2022, at the MBA Building Excellence Awards Program
