We are working to repeal current laws that are detrimental to women's health and well-being, especially around contraception and abortion. To establish a Rape Crisis Center in AZ. This is an initiative that has been brought forth by many other

organizations over the years but didn't come to fruition. We also discussed the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment events that will be happening around the state and particularly in Phoenix leading up to the 100<sup>th</sup> year of women getting the right to vote. All of these will support our mission and goals.

At our September meeting we will bring you information about several initiatives that involve committees working on the ERA, Asylum Seekers and Immigration Reform, Reproductive Rights including sexual abuse, sex trafficking and the rape crisis center. And working in conjunction with our State Policy Advocate, Carol Consalvo, on Legislation, Get Out the Vote, and Town Halls.
