Wishes for a Happy New Year

Many in the traditional Jewish community refuse to celebrate what they call the secular new year. January 1 among the very Orthodox is just another day, while the first day of Tishrei - Rosh Hashanah - is the real and only new year. Though I understand the religious sentiment from which this comes - wanting to focus on our heritage - we can't help but get caught up in the cultural holidays of the society in which we live. January 1 is the new year, and though we personally may not formally make resolutions for the new year, we can certainly reflect on what has transpired and what we hope to change in the year ahead.

As you may recall, as I shared with you on Rosh Hashanah, this past year has been filled with personal challenges and family illness. Though, thank God, most have been resolved, some are ongoing. I thank you for your concern and support. I also know that many of you are dealing with your own health and other issues. It is gratifying to see how our Chesed committee has been there for you in your time of need and how our community always supports one another. May we be blessed in this new year with continued support and with good health.

This past year has also seen a dramatic rise in antisemitic acts of violence and rhetoric. Celebrities have spewed their racist venom and though some have suffered financially for their rants, it is clear that the hatred is being well received. As of this writing, the vice president's husband - Doug Emhoff - convened a White House sponsored event to raise awareness and begin to brainstorm ways in which we can combat this rising tide of hatred. I pray that in this coming year that the commission bears fruit and that we will see a dramatic decline in this frightening trend.

May 2023 be a year of peace and justice. May it be one of health and happiness for you and your family.

The children of Chavaya had a fantastic Hanukkah celebration on December 18 that included some singing, a competitive Hanukkah Quiz Show, and activities including cookie decorating, card making, a dreidel tournament, and eating lots of latkes!

When we get together again on January 8 there will be a special program about performing Mitzvot/Commandments and how we can help people around us in ways both big and small. The morning will begin with a back-to-school breakfast.

After the children reconnect over a meal they will participate in learning about mitzvot as well as doing some projects that put mitzvot into action, all the while learning about each one they are performing.

Chavaya classes return to their regular program later in January. Kitah Bet will focus on the time that we mark as holy, such as Shabbat and the Sh'mita/Sabbatical Year; Kitah Gimel will begin their next Doing Jewish unit, Community Responsibility; and Kitah Alef will discuss what a Jewish home looks like it, including the symbols that are found. There will be a small change in personnel for Kitah Dalet as Morah Sara leaves for a semester abroad; assistant teacher Morah Donie will take over as the teacher for the class for the rest of the year. Looking ahead to February, we will have a school-wide Tu B'Shevat Seder on the 5th, then begin learning more about Purim late in the month.

If your child has not experienced Junior Congregation yet this year consider coming in January 21 for the next time we gather. It is never too late to get in on the fun! Each month brings surprises that make that Shabbat special.

Programs like the mitzvah one coming up on January 8 can only be successful with help from parents like you. If you have not helped with something previously this year I invite you to contact me to discuss volunteering - it is a fun way to see what is happening with your child(ren) on Sunday mornings!

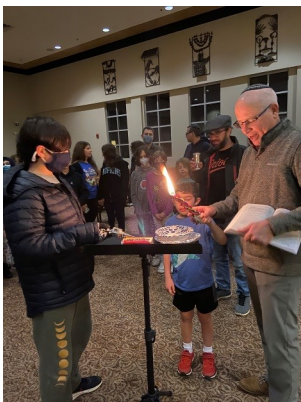

NEW SUPPORT GROUP

A support group for family members of those with dementia to start in January 2023.

Lori Marshall, LMSW, and associated with Olney Counseling Center, as well as fellow congregant, will start facilitating **"a support group for family members (spouse, parent, sibling, partner) of those with dementia."**

The support group known as *Chug Chesed* or "Kindness Circle," will start in the second week of January 2023 through June 2023, and will meet over zoom twice a month for an hour each session.

The group will create a confidential space for participants to give and receive support on their journey. Shul members will have the opportunity to speak candidly, share their experiences, and listen to peers in all stages of their experience. While everyone's experience is unique, being with others on a similar path can be powerful and healing.

This is a pilot program sponsored by your Chesed Committee of Shaare Tefila.

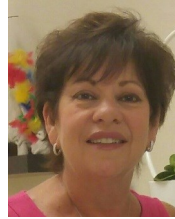

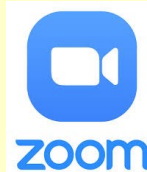
