Why should you participate?




Why study the McLean CBC?

The majority of the Comprehensive Plan recommendations for the McLean CBC are 20 years old and the county and the community recognize the need to update the Plan.

What is the Comprehensive Plan?

The Comprehensive Plan is required by state law to be used as a guide to decision-making about the natural and built environment by the county's Board of Supervisors, and others such as the Planning Commission and the Board of Zoning Appeals. What exactly is a Community Business Center or CBC?

A Community Business Center (or CBC) is a Comprehensive Plan policy designation that encourages development with a mix of uses focused around a core area of higher intensity, such as a town center or mainstreet in a pedestrian-oriented setting surrounded by transitional areas of lesser intensity. CBCs are typically older community-serving commercial areas that have emerged along major roadways. The McLean CBC is approximately 230 acres and is centered around the intersection of Old Dominion Drive and Chain Bridge Road and is located south of Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123).
