

## Ontario Public Health Measures - Restaurants, Bars, other Food and Drink Establishments (updated Feb 18, 2021)

2 metre minimum or impermeable barrier required between tables</li> <li>Limit of 6 people may be seated together</li> <li>Dancing, singing and performing music is permitted, with restrictions</li> <li>Karaoke permitted, with restrictions (including no private rooms)</li> <li>Require patron contact information for all seated patrons</li> <li>No buffet style service</li> <li>Line-ups and patrons congregating outside venues managed by venue; 2 metre minimum or impermeable barrier required between tables</li> <li>Capacity limits where physical distancing can be maintained: 50 patrons seated indoors</li> <li>Outdoor dining, takeout, drive through and delivery permitted, including alcohol</li> <li>Limit of 4 people may be seated together</li> <li>Dancing, singing and performing music is permitted, with restrictions</li> <li>Karaoke permitted, with restrictions (including no private rooms)</li> <li>Require patron contact information for all seated patrons</li> <li>No buffet style service</li> <li>Line-ups and patrons congregating outside venues managed by venue; 2 metres distance and face covering required</li> <li>Screening of patrons is required, in accordance with <a href="#">instructions issued by the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health</a></li> <li>Face coverings required except when eating or drinking only</li> <li>Personal protective equipment, including eye protection, required when a worker must come within 2 metres of another person who is not wearing a face covering</li> <li>Establishments must be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.</li> <li>Liquor sold or served only between 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.</li> <li>No consumption of liquor permitted between 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.</li> <li>Limit volume of music to be low enough that a normal conversation is possible</li> <li>Night clubs and strip clubs only permitted to operate as a restaurant or bar</li> <li>A <a href="#">safety plan</a> is required to be prepared and made available upon request</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Require patrons to be seated; 2 metre minimum or impermeable barrier required between tables</li> <li>Outdoor dining, take out, drive through, and delivery permitted, including alcohol</li> <li>Limit of 4 people may be seated together</li> <li>Outdoor dining, take out, drive through and delivery permitted, including alcohol</li> <li>Dancing, singing and the live performance of music is prohibited</li> <li>Require contact information for all seated patrons</li> <li>No buffet style service</li> <li>Line-ups and patrons congregating outside venues managed by venue; 2 metres distance and face covering required</li> <li>Face coverings required except when eating or drinking only</li> <li>Personal protective equipment, including eye protection required when a worker must come within 2 metres of another person who is not wearing a face covering</li> <li>Establishments must be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.</li> <li>Liquor sold or served only between 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.</li> <li>No consumption of liquor permitted between 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.</li> <li>Limit volume of music to be low enough that a normal conversation is possible</li> <li>Screening of patrons is required, in accordance with instructions issued by the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health</li> <li>Night clubs and strip clubs only permitted to operate as restaurant or bar</li> <li>A <a href="#">safety plan</a> is required to be prepared and made available upon request</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Indoor and outdoor service prohibited</li> <li>Take out, drive through and delivery permitted, including alcohol</li> </ul>
