This Miami-Dade County focused program provides graduates with a groundwork to become climate resilience educators, leaders, and innovators in their own communities and beyond.

Participants will learn to

-  Bring voice and power to all seats of decision-making to ensure all community voices are heard and respected.
-  Expose and challenge how poverty and discrimination make communities vulnerable to climate change.
-  Effectively advocate for practices and policies that strengthen the resiliency of Miami communities.
-  Educate community members on basic climate science, threats, and solutions.
