2025 Ouida Keck Professional Development Award for the Independent Piano Teacher

Annual Award: \$2000

The Ouida Keck Professional Development Award for the Independent Piano Teacher, named for Past National President Dr. Ouida Keck (1999-2003), is offered annually and provides \$2000 financial assistance to an independent piano teacher who demonstrates success in their private teaching and who strives to improve and enhance their teaching skills in the private studio.

Funds are to be used for advanced training through piano pedagogy classes; private piano lessons; attendance at conferences and conventions featuring piano pedagogy; purchase of new instruments, piano literature, method books, computers, computer software, or any other equipment needed to enhance the teaching environment. Funds are not available for scholarly research.
