ABOUT CULTIVATE SMALL BUSINESS


The Santander's Cultivate Small Business program provides education, coaching, and grants to early stage food entrepreneurs in low-income neighborhoods, with a focus on supporting food businesses owned by women, people of color, and immigrants.

Throughout the program, each participant develops a strategy and action plan to sustain or grow their business.

A key part of the program — and often the most meaningful to participants — is the one-on-one mentoring with a seasoned industry professional (you!).

TIME COMMITMENT

3 hour time commitment between mid-April to end of June. You will meet with your mentee for 1 hour for at least 3 meetings after getting matched.
