Program Wide Expectations

Program-wide expectations provide Skylands Learning Center with a shared focus and language for describing behavior expectations to children, staff, and families.

Program-wide expectations are broad concepts that should apply to all people and in all settings. These will be used in positive ways to maintain focus on what children are supposed to be doing. Children learn the expectations because adults in the environment, and sometimes peers, use the language of expectations when talking to children. Doing this by providing descriptive feedback to children when they meet these PWE expectations.
