

North Washington Street Bridge Replacement

Project Advisory May 22, 2020 – Project to Begin Fender System Installation

As was noted in the May 15 look-ahead for the project, on May 26, the North Washington Street Bridge project will begin installation of the fender system which protects the temporary bridge from being hit by passing boats. Completion of the fender system will allow vehicles and pedestrians to be placed onto the temporary bridge and demolition of the permanent North Washington Street Bridge to begin.

The installation of the fender system will not have an impact on vehicle or pedestrian traffic passing over the bridge. Vessels will still be able to travel under the bridge to pass between the Charles River and Boston Harbor.

Work Hours

- Tuesday May 26 to Saturday May 30: 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Monday June 1 to Saturday June 6: 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.

Once the 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. working hours begin, it is currently anticipated that they will last approximately 30 days until completion of the fender system.

Travel Tips

Drivers should take care to pay attention to all signage and move carefully through the work zone. Police details, lane markings, temporary barriers, traffic cones, signage, and other tools will be used to control traffic and create safe work zones.
