



From “Come and See” to “Go and Make”---A Discipleship Series

Oct. 16, 2019 Session One: A Practical Introduction to Evangelization

Evangelization is every Christian's call to share the Good News of the Gospel. This presentation will clarify the terms Evangelization and New Evangelization and encourage all to develop an Evangelizing spirit and vision.

Oct. 23, 2019 Session Two: A Jesus Vision Changes Everything: *Evangelize or Fossilize!*

Many Catholics only have an academic knowledge of Jesus and don't realize that the spiritual life goes beyond religious practices, prayers, and piety. This presentation encourages all to have an intimate encounter with Jesus and to follow him daily.

Oct. 30, 2019 Session Three: Discipleship: *It All Begins with you!*

The first priority of disciples of Christ is to “go and make disciples” of others. Participants will look at definitions of discipleship, will investigate how Jesus Evangelized in the gospels, and will discern a personal & communal vision of discipleship and Evangelization.

Nov. 6, 2019 Session Four: What is the Kerygma? (A Clue) *It Doesn't Go in Gumbo!*

Kerygma is an unfamiliar term to many Catholics. From a Greek word it means herald or one who proclaims. The kerygma is the initial proclamation designed to introduce a person to Christ. It is vitally important to discipleship making and Evangelization. Kerygmatic proclamation and catechesis are two necessary and mutually enriching components of Evangelization. Often there is general imbalance in the Church, which unfortunately tends to place greater emphasis on catechesis at the expense of the kerygma resulting in un-Evangelized Catholics in the pews. Both are important but each needs to be in the queue in proper order. This presentation will summarize the message of the kerygma and its intended response, which leads to Christ-centered action.

Nov. 13, 2019 Session Five: Making Other Disciples: *Entering the Mission Field*

The Church exit door sign read, “You are now entering your mission territory.” Evangelizing Catholic's need to be intentional, creative, and engaging in living out this mission. This presentation will assist all to move from maintenance to mission. Crucial session takeaways will identify prayer infused strategies that create disciples and parishes that create an attractive culture of invitation and welcome—for the Lord.
