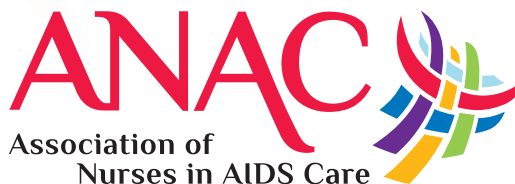
National Transgender HIV Testing Day
