

Joint Announcement about *JANAC*'s move to Wolters Kluwer Publishing

ANAC is pleased to announce that Wolters Kluwer has been selected as the new publisher for *JANAC* beginning in January 2019. Elsevier has published *JANAC* for more than a decade and we made great strides forward under their direction. We sincerely appreciate their valuable stewardship of the journal; however, our contract was up for renewal at the end of 2018, and the decision was made to put out a request for proposals (RFP) to determine (a) the value of *JANAC* in the publishing marketplace, and (b) the variety of services that might be available from other publishers. A selection committee that included ANAC Board Members and the *JANAC* Editorial team participated in the RFP process and met with three finalists before the ANAC conference in Dallas in November 2017.

The final selection was made by the committee and the ANAC Board approved the committee's recommendation to move the journal's publishing contract to Wolters Kluwer. Most of you will be familiar with Lippincott Williams & Wilkins (publishers of many nursing textbooks), which is a part of Wolters Kluwer. We are excited about this move and the benefits that will be offered by our new publisher, including continuing education credits attached to *JANAC* articles; alliance with a large number of other health-focused journals, many of which are nursing titles; and a brand new look.

Expect to see major changes in 2019, which is also the 30th anniversary of *JANAC*. We hope you will be part of this important year in *JANAC*'s history by submitting your papers, serving as a peer reviewer, and reading the high quality content.
