CALL FOR PAPERS

The *Journal of the Association of Nurses in AIDS Care* (JANAC) plans to publish a special issue on the topic of **Resilience & Wellbeing throughout the Lifespan of People Living with HIV** in the beginning of 2022. We are seeking feature articles (including original research and systematic reviews), as well as practice briefs, program briefs, commentaries, and case studies. We encourage a critical uptake of the concepts of resilience and wellbeing. Of special interest are manuscripts in the following areas:

- Novel research methodologies and methods to study resilience and wellbeing among people living with HIV
- Theoretical approaches, models and interventions which emphasize living and aging well with HIV
- Promoting resilience and wellbeing among people living with HIV throughout the lifespan including separate manuscripts on the following special populations
 - Perinatally infected/pediatric patients living with HIV
 - Older adults living with HIV
 - Women living with HIV
 - Individuals from diverse sexual and gender populations
 - Racial and ethnically diverse populations
 - People Living with HIV in Low and Middle Income Countries
- Policy analyses of legislation impacting resilience and wellbeing of people living with HIV
- Insights gained on resilience by long-term HIV survivors and affected communities
- Research focused on understanding resilience and wellbeing in relation to HIV as political concepts
