

Tri-City Country Club Business League 2016

2 Player Team Gross & Net Match Play Scorecard Example

On each hole there are 2 points available, 1 point for gross and 1 point for net. Each match will have 20 points available.

On each hole, the team best ball score gross and net will win the point, lose the point or halve the point with the opposing team. The low Handicap player in the group will always play to a scratch handicap and the other players will receive the difference in handicaps in dots on the card to determine net scores. Business League handicapping will be used and will be re-calculated weekly. **Keep track of the match by writing a 1, 1/2, or a 0 in the gross points and net points rows.**

At the end of the round add these points together for a total of your point winnings on the night. The team with the most points gross will add 1 to this total and the same with the most points net. If the 2 teams are tied on either gross or net, each team will add 1/2 point to their total. The total points earned from both teams will always add up to 20. **(9 points gross, 9 points net & 1 point for winning the total gross and/or net matches.)**

Gross & Net points will accumulate during the season and we will pay the top point earning teams at the end of the season. Weekly payout will be gross and net skins game & closest to the pin competitions.

Attached is a sample scorecard to show how to score the match.
