

Langleys Interred in Vine Lake Cemetery Lot 41

1. **William Langley**

son of Samuel and Esther (Mayo) Langley

Born 14 Aug 1782 Warwick, Franklin, MA

Died 9 Oct 1828 at age 46 Boston, Suffolk, MA

Presumably 1) buried first unknown cemetery, Roxbury, Suffolk, MA; disinterred and buried second in Lot 41, or 2) buried in Lot 41, disinterred while the tomb was built, and reinterred in the tomb

2. **Alona (Clark) Langley**

great-granddaughter of Benjamin Clark who built the Peak House, granddaughter of Asa and Zillah (Chenery) Clark, daughter of William and Hannah (Peters) Clark, wife of William Langley

Born 7 Nov 1789 Medfield, Norfolk, MA

Died 27 Sep 1862 at age 72 Roxbury, Suffolk, MA

Presumably 1) buried first unknown cemetery, Roxbury, Suffolk, MA; disinterred and buried second in Lot 41, or 2) buried in Lot 41, disinterred while the tomb was built, and reinterred in the tomb

3. **Alona Langley**

daughter of William and Alona (Clark) Langley

Born 17 Jul 1812 Roxbury, Suffolk, MA

Died 24 Dec 1877 at age 65 Medfield, Norfolk, MA

Presumably 1) buried first unknown cemetery, Roxbury, Suffolk, MA; disinterred and buried second in Lot 41, or 2) buried in Lot 41, disinterred while the tomb was built, and reinterred in the tomb

4. **William Clark Langley**

son of William and Alona (Clark) Langley and funder of the tomb

Born 15 Nov 1810 Roxbury, Suffolk, MA

Died 9 Dec 1890 at age 80 Brooklyn, Kings, NY

Interred 12 Dec 1890 Vine Lake Cemetery Lot 41

5. **Edith May (Langley) Maloney**

granddaughter of William Clark and Sarah Ann Hunt (Prentiss) Langley, daughter of William Henry and Mara Belle (Shepard) Langley, wife of Clarence Bernard Maloney

Born 1 May 1885 Brooklyn, Kings, NY

Died 9 Jul 1922 at age 37 Plainfield, Sullivan, NH

Interred at an unknown date Vine Lake Cemetery Lot 41
