

# BUSINESS RECOVERY PROGRAM

ENDING AUGUST 2, 2021

The Business Recovery Program has been in place since May 2020. The program was created to help businesses when they were forced to close and/or operate at limited capacity. Initially, the City expected to keep the program in place until establishments were able to operate at 100%; however, the Board of Commissioners has kept the program going well beyond that time frame. The program allows businesses:

- 1 Outdoor Display of Merchandise
- 2 Outdoor Display of Signage (including banners, flags, balloons, etc.)
- 3 Temporary Outdoor Dining on Private and/or Public Property Without a Sidewalk Cafe License

At its meeting on April 13, 2021, the Board of Commissioners approved extending the program to Monday, August 2, 2021. After this date, these allowances will no longer be in effect. Please make appropriate plans so your business is in compliance by Monday, August 2.

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## A-FRAME SIGNS

CHANGES EFFECTIVE 08.02.2021\*

### 1 FRAME MATERIAL

A-Frame/Sandwich board sign frames shall be manufactured of a wood or metal frame material.

### 2 FACE MATERIAL

Sign faces shall be limited to chalk boards, dry-erase boards or changeable face inserts that are integrated into the original design/construction of the sign.

### 3 SIGN FEATURES

Paper, poster-board, cardboard, cloth, plastic, string, or any other material(s) may not be fastened, taped, glued, or otherwise affixed to any part of the sign structure.

\* A-Frame/Sandwich board signs not meeting the above criteria by Monday, August 2, 2021 will be referred to Code Enforcement for compliance.
