

**To be eligible for a New Hampshire ETC Scholarship:**

1. You must be a New Hampshire resident.
2. You must have a child/children between the ages of 5 and 20 who have not graduated from high school and are entering Kindergarten or 1st grade for the first time OR entering 2nd-12th grades and coming from a public school.
3. Your household income must not exceed 300% of the federal poverty level. See the income chart [here](#).

**Students will only be eligible for an ETC scholarship award when:**

1. their online ETC requal application is completed
2. all of their ETC income & supporting documents have been submitted and verified by CSFNH, and
3. St. Thomas Aquinas High School completes the School Commitment Form (SCF) in the scholarship database.

Please login into your scholarship database to complete any outstanding SCFs and be sure to check your system often.

**Crediting Family Accounts for Approved ETC Awards**

CSFNH will start approving 25/26 ETC applications in June. Once a student is "Approved" by CSFNH, the ETC scholarship award is assured as long as the student continues to meet all of the ETC eligibility requirements. *Best practice is to immediately credit the entire annual ETC scholarship award to the approved student's tuition billing account.* This will make the monthly tuition payments more in line with the families' ability to pay and minimize any "overpayments" during the school year.
