



- November 30th, 2023 Active members are able to access the Trisura on-line portal. The portal will allow members to log on, answer some questions in regards to their professional practice and select their preferred method of payment (cheque, installments or credit card). Upon payment, a certificate of insurance and receipt will be issued to the member.
- January 15th, 2024 Deadline for insurance payments before a late fee will apply.
- January 31st, 2024 Final date for payment. If invoices are not paid by this date, the member will have their coverage cancelled.
