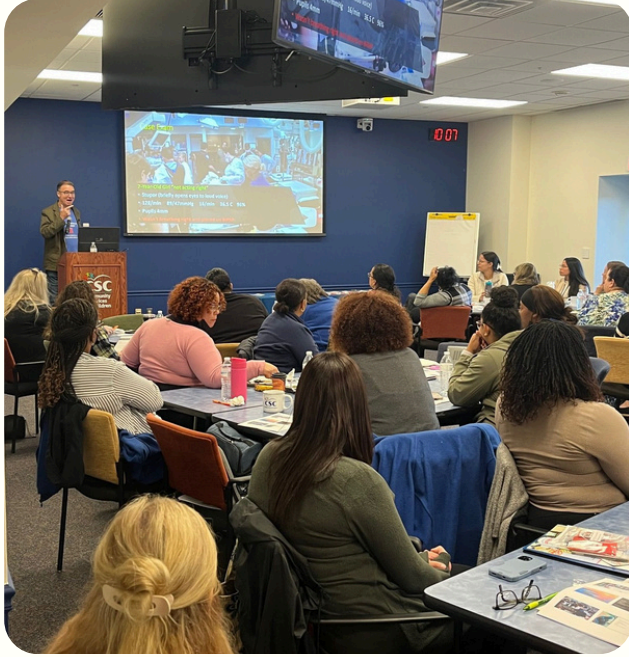
Project Child Forum

Community Services for Children extends sincere appreciation to Dr. Kevin Osterhoudt and Robert Yetman from the Poison Control Center at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) for providing an outstanding presentation on THC awareness and child safety. Attendees gained valuable insight into the growing incidence of THC-related poisonings among children, the factors contributing to these exposures, and the physical symptoms to recognize. The session included an interactive demonstration illustrating how easily THC-infused edibles can resemble common candies, reinforcing the critical importance of education and prevention in keeping children safe.
