# Reporting Information

## When to call 911:

- To report a crime in progress
- To report a fire
- To save a life

## When to call Police Non-Emergency:

- Any crime to a person not life-threatening
- Burglary to a home not in progress
- Auto theft not in progress
- After hours parking complaints
- After hours loud music complaints

## Did you Know You can File a Police Report Online?

For non-emergency crimes such as:

- Damaged or lost property, vandalism
- Lost or stolen checks/credit cards/ATM cards
- Theft or lost property
- Vandalism or theft from/to a vehicle

## When to call 311:

To report issues related to municipal services such as:

- Sidewalk and road repairs
- Noise complaints
- Abandoned vehicles
- Large debris blocking roadways
- Trash issues or garbage bin replacements
- Dangerous animal complaints
- Damaged traffic signals or road signs
- Graffiti removal
- Leaking hydrant or sewer problems
